**\*Opening:** The regularly scheduled meeting was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Nelson R. Beam, Vice Chairman.

(1) <u>Melissa Sarnocinski and Kelly Spica - Ephrata National Bank:</u> The bank will be opening a branch office in Morgantown in the near future. Ms. Sarnocinski offered some rates for Money Market accounts and Certificate of Deposits. Mr. Beam said the township will take this information under advisement and thanked them for coming.

### (2) Brian Spray – Rettew Associates representing Mr. Cone – Devonshire Hills Final Minor Subdivision:

The list of waivers from Cedarville Engineering Group's letter of April 15, 2016 were reviewed, then the list of conditions were discussed.

<u>Motion:</u> Mr. Daniel made the following motion: To give final plan approval contingent on the following items being met:

- 1. Compliance with Cedarville Engineering Group. LLC's April 15, 2016 review letter
- 2. Note 6 on the plan shall be revised to indicate that a deed of dedication for the additional right of way to the township. The deed of dedication shall be prepared and tendered to the township and recorded simultaneously with the final plan
- 3. Note 28 on plan shall be revised to state that "No land development plans or building permit plans for Lots 1, 2 and 3 shall be approved..."
- 4. Note 29 on plan shall be revised to state that "No land development plans or building permit plans for Lots 1, 2 and 3 shall be approved..."
- 5. Note 31 shall be revised to state that Applicant shall record an access easement and maintenance agreement for the shared driveway which will provide access to Lots 1 and 2 simultaneously with the final plan; and
- 6. Note 36 on Plan shall be revised to indicate that Applicant shall record a deed restriction prohibiting further subdivision which shall be recorded simultaneously with the final plan.

**(3) Vernon Weaver Land Development Plan 101 Hedge Road, Elverson, PA 19520**: the approval letter from Cedarville Engineering dated April 14, 2016 was reviewed.

<u>Motion:</u> Mr. Daniel made the motion to give contigent Preliminary/Final Plan approval to Vernon Weaver Dairy Operation at 101 Hedge Road, Elverson, PA contigent on compliance to Cedarville Engineering Group, LLC letter dated April 14, 2016 as well as supplying a conformation letter from Sunoco Pipeline, L.P. regarding their easement. Mr. Beam made the second. All in favor.
