ORDINANCE NO. 119

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST NANTMEAL, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP TO ENTER A CABLE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT WITH SERVICE ELECTRIC CABLEVISION, INC. WHICH ESTABLISHES THE CONTRACTURAL PROVISIONS PURUSANT TO WHICH THE TOWNSHIP WILL GRANT TO SERVICE ELECTRIC CABLEVISION, INC. A NON-EXCLUSIVE, REVOCABLE CABLE COMMUNICATIONS FRANCHISE.

BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY, ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of West Nantmeal as follows:


SECTION I. The West Nantmeal Township Board of Supervisors hereby approves that certain agreement entitled "Cable Franchise Agreement between the Township of West Nantmeal and Service Electric Cablevision, Inc." (the "Agreement"), which is attached hereto and incorporated herein as if set forth herein in its entirety. If any provisions or terms in the Agreement conflict with the provisions in the West Nantmeal Township Community Antenna Television Ordinance adopted on February 11, 1991 as Ordinance No. 37-1991, the provisions in the Agreement shall prevail.

SECTION II. Severability. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts hereof. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares as its intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.

SECTION III. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon counter-execution of the Agreement by an authorized representative of Service Electric Cablevision, Inc.


