### **NEW BUSINESS:**

Brick Lane-Esther Prosser attended the Planning Commission meeting to discuss the
property on Brick Lane owned by Beverly and Calvin Stoltzfus, parcel 23-3-2-1. She was
interested to see if they could build on the West Nantmeal parcel as long as it met
requirements. It was recommended that Prosser check with the Township ordinance for
the 2017 zoning update concerning soil, and to also check with FEMA for flood plain

- map. They would then need to come back to the Planning Commission with a sketch for the PC to give a recommendation.
- 2. 106 New Road- J. Pershall is attending the zoning meeting on 5/8/18. Pershall purchased property in May 2017. House destroyed from fire, termites, and rot. He is looking to rebuild on existing spot. Left side of structure is 9 ft. off boundary line. Pershall needed to re-present to the zoning commission due to an incorrect advertisement.

**MOTION**: The Planning Commission felt that they did not need to change their motion from the March 26, 2018 meeting since there was just a change in the advertisement. Motion still stands.

**PREVIOUS MOTION**: In the event that the property is deemed not nonconformity, the Planning Commission recommends a variance from 606 setbacks not be granted. In the event that the property is nonconformity, the PC recommends that the zoning variance application addresses the requirements of Article 11.
