Engineering:

- Sunoco All pipeline crossings have been completed per Ivana Wolf.
- <u>Fidelity Contracting</u> was issued a Certificate of Occupancy on August 4, 2017. Mr. Kulakowsky will check on completion status.
- <u>Bollinger Road bridge</u> Cedarville presented a proposal for examining the bridge to determine
 the amount of necessary repairs. Ms. Camp stated that per McCormick Taylor this is not a
 county owned bridge thus the township is responsible for repairs and that PennDot could close
 the bridge if it is not repaired. Grant funding may be available for the repairs.

Motion: Mr. Elston made the motion for Cedarville to proceed with the PADEP Gp-11 permit application and was seconded by Mr. Beam. Motion carried 3-0.

• Road paving – Mr. Kulakowsky recommended that payment be sent to Dan Malloy Paving as the road paving had been completed. Mr. Elston asked that the transition area on Bollinger Road be examined before payment is issued.

Zoning Report: Danielle Stoltzfus, gave the monthly report and it will be on file in the township office.

Ms. Camp will check the zoning ordinance regarding pets in a residence/property.

Solicitor's Report:

• Inter-municipal sewer agreement to amend the 537 plan has been revised and will be presented to the municipal authority the week of September 18, 2017 when it will be adopted.

<u>Motion:</u> Mr. Daniel made the motion to authorize Ms. Camp to advertise the hearing meeting at the October 9, 2017 meeting if the agreement is approved September 20, 2017 by the municipal authority and was seconded by Mr. Elston. Motion carried 3-0.

- Wyebrook Farm Mr. Carlson asked if the township would wait until there was a response from DEP to resolve zoning issues. Ms. Camp will periodically check with Mr. Carlson and Evans Mill Environmental as to status.
