NEW BUSINESS:

 eMuniManagement- Jordan Perry, of Cedarville Engineering presented a municipal software program, called eMuniManagement to the Planning Commission Board. eMuni is an asset management software program. The program is cloud based and interactive. It is a subscription based service. The program has a one- time set-up fee of \$17,425. This cost covers the set-up, training, and ongoing text support. After the initial set up, the cost would be \$1,000 a month. There is an 18% discount if you prepay for the year. The planning commission had some concerns, including cost, that were addressed with J. Perry. He is bringing concerns back to Cedarville to see if there are any changes that can be made to make more efficient for West Nantmeal Township.

2. Medical Marijuana Ordinance- The Planning commission reviewed the draft of the Medical Marijuana Ordinance proposed by the township. The Planning Commission made a motion as follows.

Motion- J. Coffman made the motion that the Planning Commission recommends to the township that the Board of Supervisors accept the Medical Marijuana Ordinance as written. D. Collman seconded the motion. 7/7 in favor. Motion carried.
